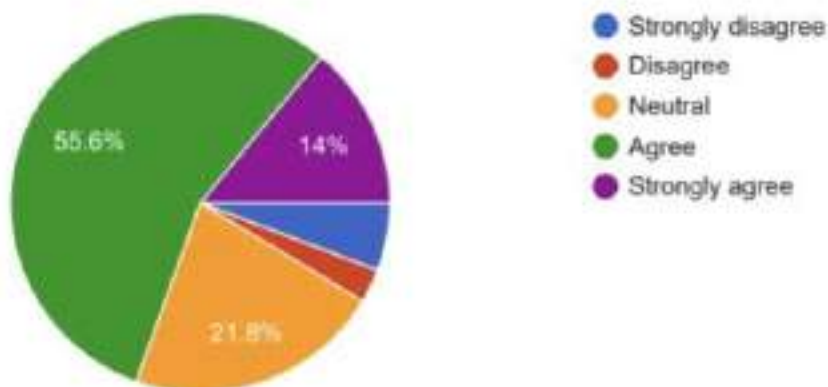

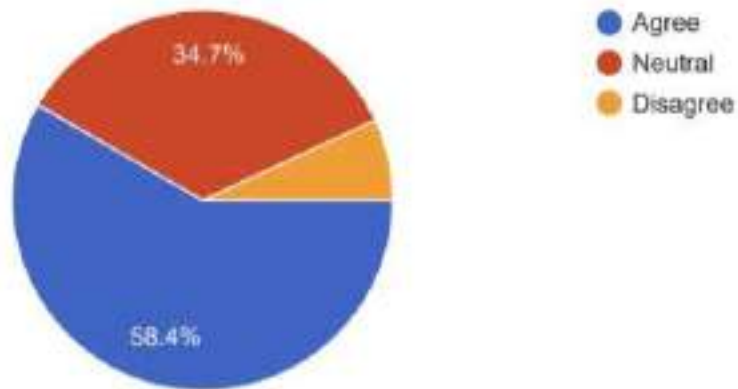

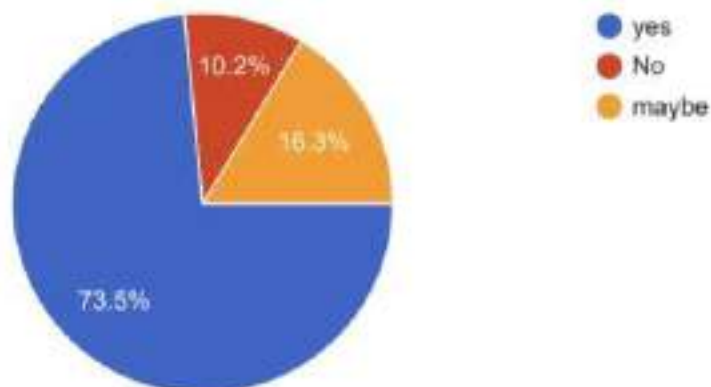

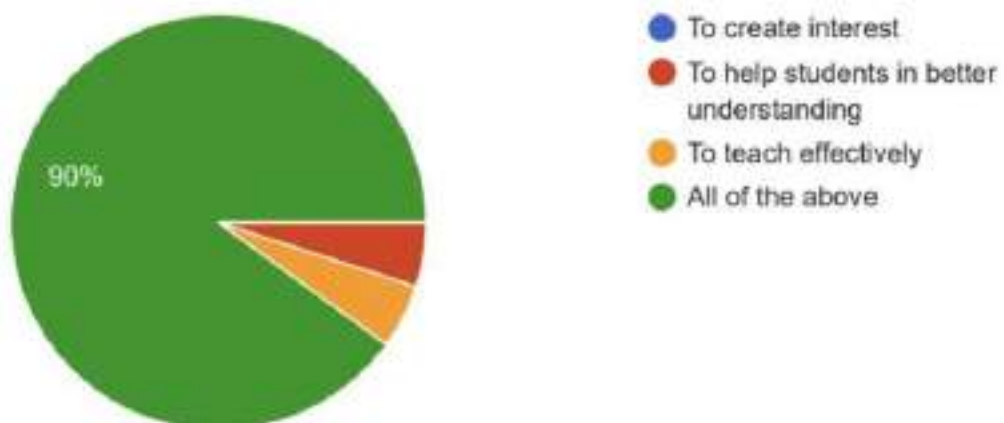

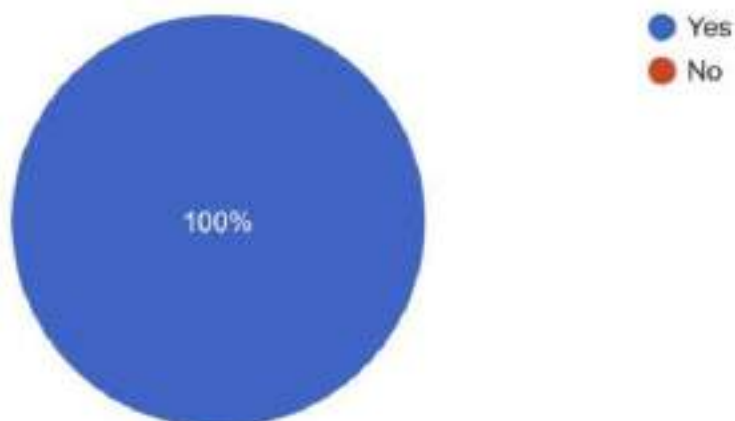

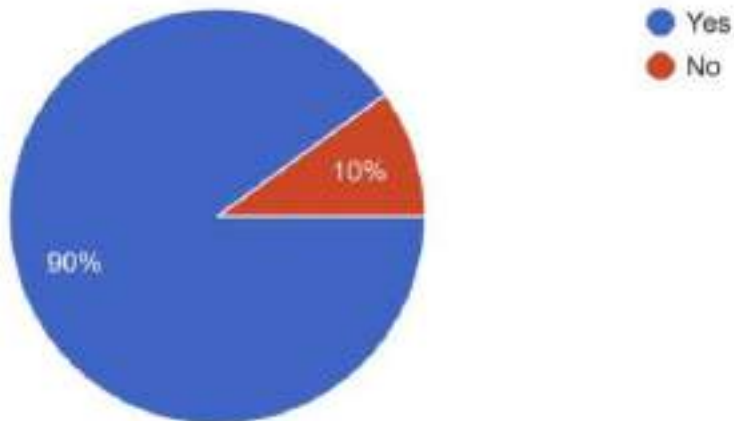

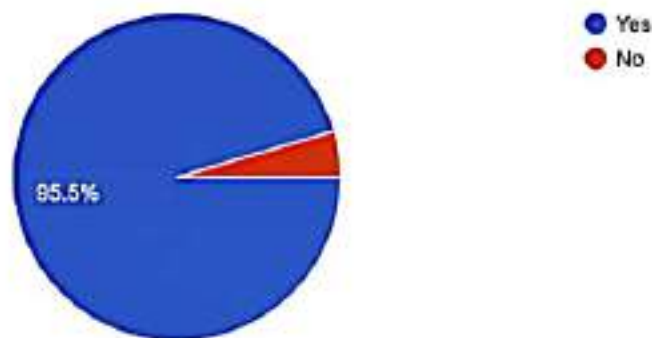

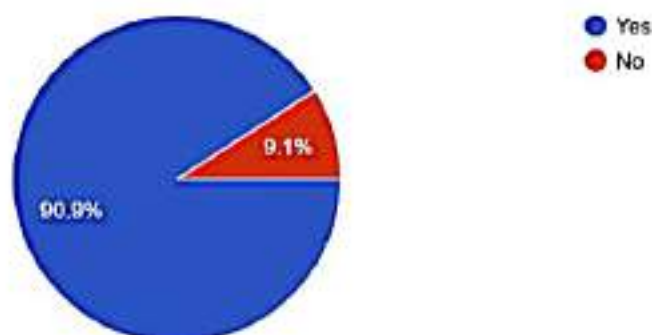

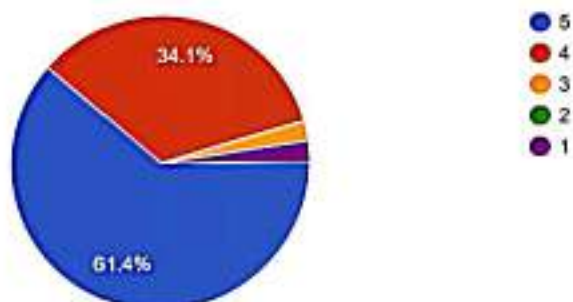

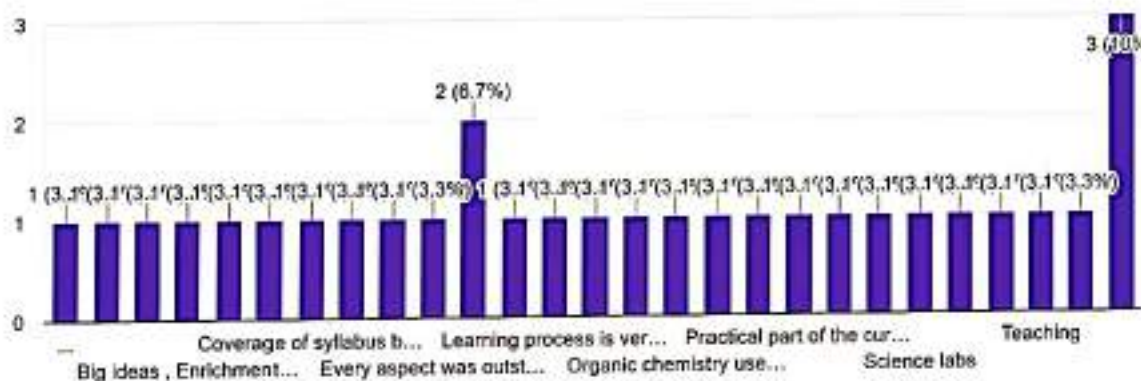

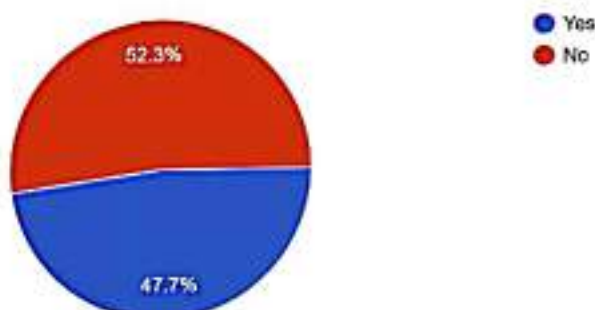

## Alumni Feedback Report:

### # Summary:

A survey was conducted among alumni to gather feedback on the curriculum's relevance and effectiveness. The results show:
